AB 3 was signed by the Governor and became law on January 1, 2008 creating the California Physician Team Practice Improvement Act. In part, AB 3 authorized a PA to administer, provide, or issue a drug order for Schedule II through V controlled substances without patient specific approval if the PA completes specified educational requirements and if his/her supervising physician delegates the authority to them. PAs completing this course and passing the post test will meet those educational requirements as defined in the above regulations.
